

# A New Family Planning Medicaid Program

*In the last 2 years, has Medicaid paid a medical bill for you while you were pregnant?*

If the answer is **yes**, then:

*Have you lost your Medicaid coverage?*

If the answer is **yes**, then:

*Have you had a Hysterectomy or a Tubal Ligation?*

If the answer is **no**, then:



*Are you interested in a program that will:*

- Pay for your birth control pills, depo shot, condom, and/or diaphragms?
- Pay for physical examinations, including a pap smear?
- Pay for pregnancy test?
- Pay for some treatments or STDs sexually transmitted diseases?

If the answer is **yes**, then:

*You may be eligible for Extended Family Planning Medicaid Benefits*

To find out if you are eligible call the County Health Department clinic nearest you or complete a Health Insurance Application for Extended Family Planning Medical Benefits and mail it to the County Health Department.

Please be sure to fully fill in the application and be as accurate as possible. Make sure that you sign it. After you are approved, you can receive these family planning services from any Medicaid provider, such as your local County Health Department Clinic.
