Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) in Florida provides nutrition services to low income pregnant or postpartum women, their infants and preschool children under age 5. The WIC Program requires that participants be in some nutritional and financial need. Participants receive nutrition counseling and education, breastfeeding support and free food or infant formula. WIC foods include milk, juice, cheese, eggs, cereal, peanut butter or beans.
